## G4 GTE Term 1 Revision: Important concepts and Blooket!

The main concepts from each unit:

- **What is active reading?**
  - Imagining as you read.
    - Make pictures in your mind or draw pictures on the page.
  - Asking questions.
    - Write down any questions that you have about what you are reading.
  - Guessing what will happen next.
    - Write down predictions about what you think will happen.
  - Marking the page.
    - Underline, circle, or highlight important parts or parts that you don't understand.
    - Draw pictures on the page.
    - Write down questions.
    - Write down predictions.
  
- **What are characters?**
  - Characters are the people or animals in a story.
  - We should use interesting adjectives to describe characters.
  
- **What is the setting?**
  - The setting is *when* and *where* a story takes place.
  - "When" can mean time of day, a season, a month, year, in the past, the present, or the future.
  - "Where" simply means a place.
  
- **What is the plot?**
  - The plot is what happens in the beginning, middle, and end of a story.
  - In the beginning of a story, we learn about the characters and setting.
  - The middle of a story is where the *climax* happens.
  - The end of a story has a solution.
  - Plot is like a graph in math.
  
- **What is a main idea and what are supporting details?**
  - The *main idea* is the most important idea in a piece of writing.
  - *Supporting details* help develop the main idea.
  - If you know the main idea, then try adding words like "so," "and," or "because" after it, and then say one of the things that you think is a supporting detail. They should be connected.
