G5 GTE Term 3 Revision: Important concepts and Blooket!

The main concepts from each unit:

1. What is a summary?

- A summary is a way to talk about the main ideas and details of a text using your own words naturally, just as you would if telling your friend about it.
 - Mark the text as you read, underlining or highlighting the main idea and details. This will be helpful to quickly identify them when you begin writing your summary.
 - Don't add any of your own information. It must all come from the text.

2. What are sensory details?

- We can use sensory details in our writing when we want the reader to see, taste, smell, feel, and hear what we are writing about.
- Sensory details make your writing more engaging and help the reader really feel what you are writing.
- When you write, think about how you would use your senses to describe something. It's fragrant? What does it smell like? It's loud? What is loud that you can compare it to? Remember to be descriptive.

3. What are similes?

- A simile is an exaggerated comparison of two things, using *like* or *as*.
- Similes compare things that we don't usually compare together, such as comparing people to animals or objects.

4. What is personification and anthropomorphism?

- **Personification** is when authors create animals or objects that are human-like.
- **Anthropomorphism** is when animals or objects dress or behave like humans. Think of your favorite Disney movie with animal characters!
- A **personifying verb** is an action that only living things can do.

5. What is character description?

- When describing characters, you can **show** how they are through their words and actions instead of just telling through adjectives. This is called "**Show, not tell.**"
- A **tribute** is a writing where the author writes about a person who is important to them. The author **shows** us who the person through examples of their personality and special stories about what they have said or done.
